



Summer Internship Program 2024

Diamond Ag Research, Inc. is an independent Agricultural Research company in Central Kansas conducting a wide variety of field efficacy, residue, and varietal experiments. The internship program will allow the intern to participate, first-hand, in field research techniques and observe developing technology.

Selected interns will assist in all aspects of field research such as, planting and establishing field experiments involving corn, sorghum, soybean, wheat, and other crops. Other research opportunities include visual evaluations of test plots, various plant sampling procedures, and test pesticide applications.

Housing will be provided for the duration of the program. In addition, student will receive a \$2,300 stipend each month.

The summer internship will run from **May 20, 2024 thru August 9, 2024**. The beginning and ending dates **are** negotiable.

Eligibility:

A successful candidate for this program will meet the following requirements:

- Must be a U.S. citizen or be eligible to work in the United States.
- Must have a valid U.S. drivers' license.
- Must currently be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student and be majoring in agronomy, biology or a related field.
- Must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher.

In addition to the above requirements the following preferred criteria will be considered when choosing interns:

- Applicants should have good verbal and written communication skills
- Candidates should be willing to put in long hours as necessary.
